
The **New Mexico Cancer Council** is dedicated to lessening the burden of cancer in our state and to improving the quality of life for **New Mexicans** living with cancer.

- About 9,300 New Mexicans will be newly diagnosed with cancer in 2013.
- About 3,000 New Mexicans die from cancer every year. CANCER IS THE SECOND LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN NEW MEXICO.
- About 97,000 New Mexicans are cancer survivors.
