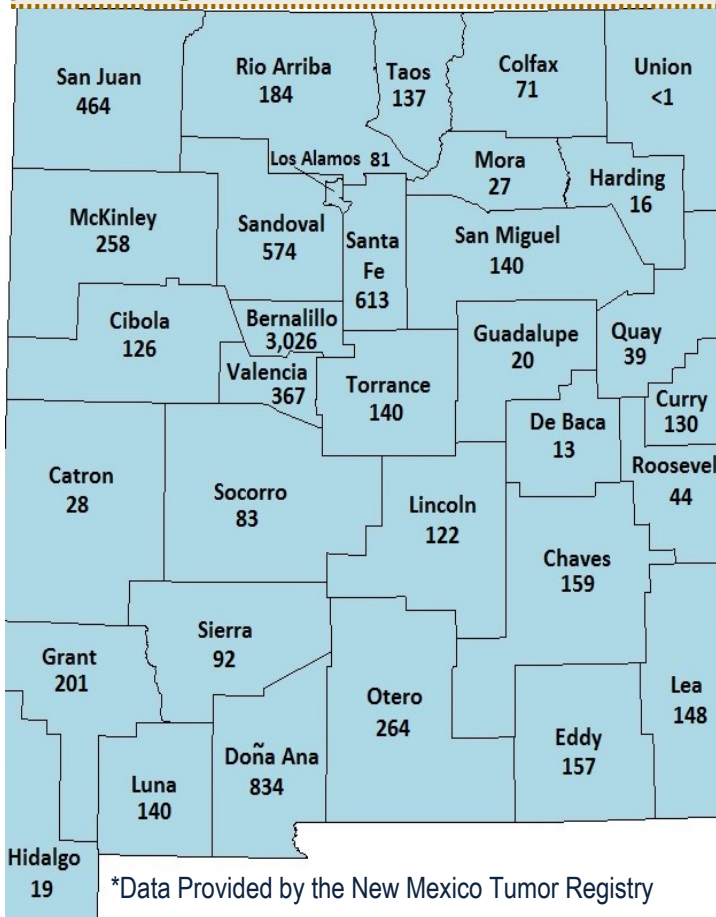
The **New Mexico Cancer Council** is dedicated to lessening the burden of cancer in our state and to improving the quality of life for **New Mexicans** living with cancer.

- ◇ Approximately **10,210** new cases of cancer were diagnosed in 2014.
- ◇ About **3,600** New Mexicans die from cancer every year.
- ◇ **CANCER IS THE SECOND LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN NEW MEXICO.**
- ◇ About **97,000** New Mexicans are cancer survivors.
